SGF native sets women's world record: 100-mile run

Gina (Shaw) Slaby, a U.S. Navy officer and 1999 South Glens Falls graduate, is the new world woman's record holder in the 100-mile run. She shattered the existing mark by nearly two minutes last weekend in the Desert Solstice Invitational in Phoenix, Arizona.

Gina (Shaw) Slaby, 35, a naval officer, finished in 13 hours & 46 minutes, 8:15 per mile

Mrs. Slaby, 35, ran 100 miles around a high school track in 13 hours, 45 minutes and 49 seconds. It broke by nearly two minutes Ann Trason's record

set in 1991. Mrs. Slaby averaged eight minutes and 15 seconds per mile.

She is the daughter of Donna Groome of Fort Edward and the late Leonard Shaw. Her brother, Mike Shaw, still lives in Gansevoort, where Mrs. Slaby grew up.

"It's the pinnacle of my running career, so it's a pretty amazing feeling," she told *The Chronicle* via email. "I have been training really hard for so long and it has finally paid off."
