Adk. Wine & Food Fest in LG June 29-30

The 8th annual Adirondack Wine & Food Festival in Lake George on **Saturday and Sunday, June 29 and 30**, is touted as their biggest yet, featuring more than 140 New York wineries, food producers and vendors at the Charles R. Wood Festival Commons.

The family-friendly event is presented by Adirondack Festivals, an offshoot of Adirondack Winery. They anticipate around 7,000 attendees this year

The line-up has "29 wineries, 25 artisan food vendors, 17 food trucks, 20 distilleries, 9 nonalcoholic beverage producers, 5 cideries, 4 breweries, 3 meaderies, and more than 14 craft and specialty vendors."

Admission on Saturday is \$50 with souvenir glass and tastings. The \$99 VIP adds goodie bag, tent access and early ad-
