No, there won't be dueling fireworks on July 3 in Glens Falls. Yes, the show will go on as planned in Crandall Park as climax of the Glens Falls Symphony Orchestra Pops Concert. But, no, the promoted July 3 fireworks at East Field with the Glens Falls Dragons baseball game **won't happen.**

Mayor Bill Collins told *The Chronicle* Wednesday afternoon, "The city never received an event application...and didn't know it was planned until last Thursday when the fireworks provider sent an application for a fireworks license...We can't approve a fireworks app without an event plan that would need
