"We're expecting tens of thousands of people" for the Fourth of July in Lake George Village, Mayor Ray Perry tells *The Chronicle*. It's the Village's biggest fireworks show of the season, he said. Expect massive crowds. Mayor Perry suggests **arriving early** to find parking — **and staying late.**

"The main message I try to get to people is, **don't all leave at once,**" Mayor Perry says. "The fireworks ends, and, hey, have an ice cream cone or a slice of pizza or candy apple. Walk around a little. Let it happen gradually, rather than everybody runs to their car and they all just bottleneck."

As for parking, "we have close to 800 parking spaces available in the Village, both metered and
