



Cannabis stink in Moreau

A cannabis field off of Northway Exit 17 has raised a stink in Moreau, as nearby residents complain about the strong odor the plants are giving off.

The property in question is 63 Spier Falls Road, owned by Saratoga Springs-based Shangri-La Real Estate Holdings.

The growing of cannabis at the site seemed to catch the town by surprise. An Aug. 19 notice of violation sent from Moreau Building, Planning and Development Coordinator Josh Westfall to Shangri-La owner Orson Klender said that the town became aware of "what appeared to be a growing opera-
