NY Times owner key in Temple Beth El's launch 100 years ago

One day in the fall of 1924 — exactly 100 years ago — members of a reform Jewish congregation in Glens Falls gathered after High Holiday services in a donated hall to discuss fundraising for a temple to serve the congregation of 35 families.

Congregation member Ella Cline wrote about that important time in Temple Beth El (Marion Avenue) history. She reported that an unfamiliar man, after “quietly and unobtrusively” joining the worshippers that day, said he wanted to join the congregation, wrote a check and
