



Anthony Constantino, CEO of Sticker Mule, the Amsterdam, NY-based international custom printing company, is running for the New York 21st Congressional District seat expected to be vacated when Elise

Stefanik becomes the U.S. ambassador to the United Nations in January, Fox News reported Sunday. The Fox article said Mr. Constantino, 40, was "formerly a registered Democrat."

Mr. Constantino told *The* Chronicle Tuesday in a text exchange he changed his registration to Republican last week, and noted, "I donated to and voted for President Trump in 2016, 2020 and 2024."
