The former shirt factory at

2-15 Broad Street faces Broad, South and Pine Streets. Mr. O'Neill put it on the market last spring for

\$2.35 million. The couple are RPI grads. Ryan graduated from South Glens Falls High School

in 2003. Erin graduated from Queensbury that same year. They have been renovating buildings since 2008. "We've


